




THE INTROVERT ASSOCIATION: CREATING THE INT


When we were starting this project, we had to do many iterations and proofs. I chose to do many variations of blue because I knew blue was a key color for the Introvert Association. We also had to create proofs for all of them and include a grid on top and the pantone swatch. This was my first time working with Pantone and I enjoyed learning about it and understanding how they worked.











Our final project for Process and Production was a portrait assignment, in which we found photographs, recreated them and combined them with text to make a final portrait. I chose a random book in the library and they were all photographs by Tacita Dean. I did not realize that the book was all old men but the limitations forced me to be more creative down the road.

The backgrounds I chose to keep it more ambiguous and abstract because I wanted the face to be the central focus. In the end, I chose my recreation of Hockney because of the colors on his jacket and a landscape of a sky with contrasting water. That became a challenge at the end, trying to connect all the separate elements together to form one cohesive portrait. I found the challenge a lot of fun because it was more than simply graphics.

The text added a different element to it and it was about finding a way to treat the text as a graphic and work it in to become cohesive and to have them play off of one another. I also chose to follow the text that talks about silliness and I rotated the landscape so that it is upside down to add a sense of abstractness and playfulness.






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
